Tools

Items to include in winter wreaths could be evergreen, pine, or boxwood, berries (of all colors), eucalyptus, winter flowers, pine cones, etc... After Christmas sales are the perfect time to stock up on these items for making winter wreaths. I would shy away from ornaments when making winter wreaths so as not to look too Christmassy.
