

Supplies Needed for a SILK FLOWER SPRING WREATH

Please change the following supplies to what you have available to you in your stores. The pattern for this wreath consist of grapevine wreath, 3 medium sized flowers, filler flowers, various greenery, ribbon, bird's nest, egg.



Tools:

- Wire Cutters
- Scissors
- Ruler or Tape Measure
- Hot Glue Gun

Glue/Wire/Tape/Moss:

- 5-6 Long Glue Sticks
- 4" Wood Floral Picks
- Brown or Green Floral Tape
- 5 Brown Pipe Cleaners (3 on nest, 1 on bow, 1 for hanger)
- Sheet Moss or small silk flower leaves

Elements:

- 1 14" Round Grapevine Wreath
- 5 Yards 1.5" Wired Ribbon
- 1 5" Bird's Nest
- 3-5 Bird's Eggs
- 3 Medium Silk Flower (I used Peonies from Michaels)
- 1 Silk Flower Bouquet (I purchased at Michaels but you can substitute smaller coordinating flowers. My bush had 12 flowers)
- 1 Flowering Heather Bush (From Michael's)
- Greenery Stems
 - I used 1 Ficus Branch, 1 Long Grass Bush, 1 Short Grass Bush, 1 Green Bush with flowers (Feel free to substitute with Fern, Ivy, etc.)
