- (qty 3) PF1652 – Plastic Leaf Spray
- (qty 2) 52503BE – Satin Mini Sunflower Bush
- (qty 1) RG01685C2 – Cream/Black Swiss Dot Ribbon 1.5”
- (qty 1) RG116794 – Antique Diamond Ribbon 2.5”

Assembly Steps

1. Fluff the wreath
2. Attach the Sign
3. Attach the ribbon
4. Divide and attach greenery
5. Divide and attach flowers
6. Clean up
